

DuPage Forest Preserve Model Aircraft Flying Field Rules

1. **The flying of any form of model aircraft within the District is prohibited except in those areas designed for such use.**
2. The Waterfall Glen flying field hours are: 9:00 am until sunset.
3. **Use of designated areas shall be on a first-come first-serve basis except that exclusive use may be reserved in advance for a fee upon written request to the District.**
4. An individual using the facility must have, in their possession, a model flyer's license issued by the Academy of Model Aeronautics or other equal value proof of liability insurance and a District Model Aircraft Permit (for the county of DuPage).
5. **All aircraft must be fitted with a muffler.**
6. Per AMA recommendations, no aircraft with a weight greater than 55 pounds may be used on the field.
7. **Each flyer must have a frequency flag affixed to his or her transmitter antenna and a similar flag for the frequency control stand (colors must match) with your name and frequency printed on it.**
8. To prevent turf damage, mats or platforms must be used for fueling gasoline-powered engines.
9. **Aircraft must be flown in a safe and responsible manner at all times.**
10. Pilots will control aircraft from designated flight line in accordance with designated flight pattern. See map at your field for designated flight patterns.
11. **Transmitters should only be operated while you are flying. Double check transmitters being utilized by other operators to make sure no one is flying at the same frequency.**
12. Yield right-of-way to landing aircraft or landed aircraft on runway.
13. **Cars must be parked in the designated area only.**
14. Each flyer is responsible for leaving the field clean and neat.
