

WAM Club Point Awards

How do you earn points to bid for merchandise at the annual "Point Night Auction" (held at the first meeting in January)? The answer is - by taking part in the various club activities. Below is a list of club activities and the point values earned by volunteering.

Points Activity

100	Director – Event organizer (Event examples: Air Show, Fun Fly, Heritage Fest, Swap Meet, or other club activity) (Responsibilities: Submits event points earned by members to club VP)
15/hr.	Worker Bee – Event worker (ex: Event Setup/Cleanup, Judging, or Other Tasks)
25/hr.	Air Show Flyer – Pilots a plane at the air show.
15/hr.	Air Show Set-Up and Clean-up
25/hr.	Air Show Gate - Provide information to spectators as they pass through our gate
15/ea.	Air Show Static Aircraft - 15 points for each plane shown in the static display area
50	Fun Fly 1st place event winner (per each event)
40	Fun Fly 2nd place event winner (per each event)
30	Fun Fly 3rd place event winner (per each event)
15 + 10	Aircraft displayed per meeting – Additional 10 points, if club decal is attached.
100 + 100	Instructor – Additional 100 points for each student soloed.
200	Club Officers
10	Attendance - For each meeting attended.
75	Mowing the field.
30	Towing the mower to the field.
100	Technical session conducted.
50	Published Newsletter articles (5 to 50 maximum per newsletter)

What are WAM club points all about?

WAM club points were introduced to the club to provide club members with an incentive to participate at various club activities.

How can these points be used?

They are used/auctioned off for R/C modeling stuff (airplane kits, motors, glues, wheels, and other small item stuff). This takes place once a year at our Annual Point Night Auction (first meeting in January).

How does the auction work?

At the auction you bid the points awarded to you on merchandise selected and presented by the auctioneer. Highest bid (increments of 5) gets the selection. The only rule to abide by is ... you bid your points or someone else's points (absent member) ... BUT you CAN NOT combine your points with someone else's.
