Tentative Schedule

WAM Open House Procedures & Guidelines for Pilots

1. All AMA Safety Code, FPDDC, & club rules are applicable.
Exception: No FPV flying. Must show AMA license for registration.
2. Use transmitter impound when not flying. This includes Tx's. on 2.4 GHz.
Use pins on Frequency Control Board.
3. Use safety restraint or get assistance when starting engines. Use an overflow catch bottle and/or fuel mat. No taxiing in the pits. Hold it, or carry it.
4. East-West runway will *not* be used. Flight pattern direction of N-S to be determined.
Left hand preferred in X-wind.
5. Fly with a spotter. Call your intentions. No flying directly toward the flight line and/or spectator area. Max. of 4 aircraft at one time.
6. All flying to be conducted from the field centerline and east.
Stay short of Argonne Lab. to the north. South OK.
7. Buddy-Box: All children to be behind safety fences when given test flights. Other pilots wishing to fly during buddy-box sessions, please check with CD first.
8. 3-D, Extreme, & Hovering type flying to be performed over tall grass east of field only. Not over field. Minimum altitude of 15 feet. *Note: Hovering is boring for spectators who do not understand the ability required. Please keep it to a minimum!*
9. Solo flights and demos permitted. All you have to do is ask. Bring your own music if desired. Music must be on CD format and suitable for all ages.
10. No first time flight testing after 9:45am.
